SPORTS POLICY



Sport is an integral part of the holistic education and provides an avenue whereby a student can gain a range of skills.

RATIONALE:

Sport is an experience from which students can learn cooperation, respect for others and graciousness in both victory and defeat. In encouraging participation as well as the pursuit of excellence, the School recognises the contribution of all involved in sport at Holy Rosary Catholic School.

GUIDELINES:

1. Every effort will be made to provide equal opportunity to all students who wish to participate in a particular sport, whatever their skill level.
2. When there is conflict between commitments, students should give priority to representing their School rather than another school or club team. Exemptions may be granted to this in exceptional circumstances upon application to the Principal.
3. In representing the School, students will comply with any requirements the School may make in respect of dress, general appearance, punctuality, safety, behaviour and participation in the School's program of activities.
4. Wherever possible, students should be given the opportunity to gain selection at representative level.
5. Individual students should be given the opportunity to gain selection at representative level.
6. Students, parents, coaches and team managers are to comply with the Sports Code of Behaviour.
